The role of the Missouri Association of Student Financial Aid Personnel shall be:

- To establish and maintain high professional standards in college, university, and other postsecondary financial aid personnel.
- To establish and maintain effective relationships between high schools, colleges, and financial aid agencies, and organizations concerned with/or engaged in the support and/or administration of student financial aid both public and private.
- 3. To develop effective financial aid programs designed to encourage qualified students to pursue higher education.
- 4. To coordinate activities with other professional organizations with like objectives.
- To maintain ongoing contacts with state and national assemblies in order that new ideas, projects and problems concerning present and proposed legislation can be voiced.
- To maintain contact with federal and state officials in agencies relating to student financial aid as needed.
- 7. To initiate and maintain a program of public information concerning student financial aid, and to assist those agencies dedicated to this task.
- 8. To provide a program of exchange of information and ideas among the members of the Association.
- To provide training materials and programs which will stimulate and further professional growth and enable financial aid personnel to improve service to students.
